


# CHOW TAI FOOK

## RINGS SIZE GUIDE

- Step 1 Print the following ring size chart in its original scale\*.
- Step 2 Place your existing ring, which can be used as a size reference, flat on the ring circles in the chart and find the closest circumference size (based on the inner diameter of the ring).
- Step 3 If the size matches the dimensions on the chart, you will know your ring size. If the ring size is close to two measurements, Chow Tai Fook recommends choosing the larger size.

### \* INSTRUCTION FOR PRINTING

To achieve the best results, you will need to go to the 'printing settings' before printing and ensure that the 'page scaling' option is set to 'none' in the print dialogue box. The Chow Tai Fook Ring Size Chart must be printed on a full letter "A4 (21x29.7 cm)" size page. To check that the Ring Size Chart has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 50mm.



The above are Chow Tai Fook ring sizes

Please note that the Chow Tai Fook ring size chart is for reference only.  
The comfort level of wearing a larger or smaller ring size may vary depending on the different ring styles.
